**Official rules for LBA Queen of Hearts Progressive Raffle**

1. The Lafayette Band Association (LBA) is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization with a valid Kentucky charitable gaming license (#0841). LBA is authorized to hold Queen of Hearts raffles twice weekly, once during each Thursday and Friday Bingo session.
2. The Queen of Hearts board, purchased from a certified gaming vendor, contains 54 sealed, face-down cards numbered 1 to 54. The card positions are unknown to everyone. The same board will be used for both Thursday and Friday drawings until the Queen of Hearts is found.
3. Tickets cost \$2 each and are sold only in-person during Thursday and Friday LBA Bingo sessions at Lex Go Bingo, 1230 Eastland Dr, Lexington, KY. Sales start at 6 PM and end after Break 2 (see Bingo Program). Tickets are available to individuals aged 18 and older; ID verification may be required.
4. There is no ticket purchase limit per session. Tickets are valid only for the drawing held that night; Thursday tickets are invalid for Friday, and vice versa.
5. Ticket stubs must be placed in the drawing cylinder by the purchaser before the end of Break 2. LBA is not responsible for stubs not placed in the cylinder.
6. Purchasers must retain their matching ticket halves and be present to win. Providing a name and address on the back of each ticket stub is recommended. If the winning ticket has this information, it must match the presenter's government issued ID.
7. Each ticket must have only one owner. Tickets with multiple names are invalid. Ticket ownership without contact information is determined by who holds the matching half. Damaged tickets held by multiple individuals are invalid. LBA does not recognize group purchases.
8. Lost tickets will not be replaced.
9. The jackpot each night will be the greater of the night's ticket sales plus any carryover or \$2,000.
10. Drawings occur between games 11 and 12 on Thursdays, and between games 12 and 13 on Fridays.
11. The number of winners varies based on the board status and ticket sales:
  - a. 45+ cards: 1 winner per 75 tickets sold.
  - b. 35-44 cards: 1 winner per 100 tickets sold.
  - c. 25-34 cards: 1 winner per 150 tickets sold.
  - d. Fewer than 25 cards: 1 winner per session.
12. Winners must present the matching ticket half and complete a winner's slip with their name, address, phone number, and chosen card number. If a winning ticket has information on the back, it must match the presenter's government issued ID to be a valid winner. If multiple winners are drawn, all ticket validations and winner's slips must be completed before any cards are revealed.
13. Base winning payout:
  - a. [Version 1] Winners receive a voucher for a free card-minding device: \$30 for the first winner, \$20 for the second, and \$10 for subsequent winners.
  - b. [Version 2] All winners receive a voucher for a free \$30 card-minding device.
14. If a raffle has multiple winners, the cards indicated on the winner's slips are revealed in the order that the winning raffle tickets were drawn. If a selected card is already revealed, the winner will choose another card.
15. Prizes for revealing face cards or aces (excluding the Queen of Hearts):
  - a. Jack: \$25

- b. King: \$50
  - c. Ace: \$75
  - d. Non-QoH Queen: \$150
16. Revealing a Joker awards the winner 20% of the jackpot and LBA 10%. The jackpot is reduced by 30% for subsequent winners.
  17. Revealing the Queen of Hearts awards 2/3 of the jackpot to the winner and 1/3 to LBA. Any other winners of that raffle receive a \$150 consolation prize. No more cards are revealed.
  18. Jackpot carryover and board reset:
    - a. If the Queen of Hearts is revealed, the jackpot is fully paid out and a new board is used.
    - b. If a Joker is revealed, 30% is paid out, and 70% carries over and the same board continues.
    - c. If any other card is revealed, the full jackpot carries over and the same board continues.
  19. After the drawing:
    - a. Winning ticket(s), stub(s), and winner's slip(s) are attached to the revealed card(s), which are then reattached to the board face-up.
    - b. All non-winning tickets are destroyed as required by regulations.
  20. Once the Queen of Hearts is found, the board is retired and stored per DCG guidelines.
  21. Jackpot winners must be 18 or older and are responsible for applicable taxes. A W2G form must be completed by any prize winner. Prizes up to \$2,000 are paid in cash; amounts exceeding \$2,000 are paid via certified check mailed by the following Tuesday. Tax withholding applies to prizes of \$5,000 or more.
  22. Winners unable to provide ID or complete required paperwork have 15 days to do so. After that period, unpaid prizes revert to LBA.
  23. Prizes cannot be donated unless the winner first accepts the prize and completes all required tax documentation.
  24. LBA may amend these rules before ticket sales start for any given drawing. Announcements regarding rule changes will be made in the Bingo hall.
  25. Void where prohibited by law.
